When they are not helping animals, James and Tom enjoy playing basketball on their school team at Phoenix Ranch in Simi Valley, playing saxophone and trumpet in the school's band, and performing in theatre productions at their school and summer camps. They've been in *Grease*, *Seussical Jr.*, *Footloose*, *Little Shop of Horrors*, *Bugsy Malone*, *Phantom of the Opera*, *Pirates of Penzance*, *Cinderella*, and *Oliver Twist*, just to name a few, and are excited about this year's production of *Guys and Dolls, Jr.* James collects happy face items, and hopes to open a museum and restaurant someday, while Tom loves wearing cool fedora hats, and plans on becoming an architect.
