Dear Supporters:



He tested positive for leukemia, and the rescue group did not have a facility for a cat with this condition. The C.A.R.E. sanctuary has a separate area exclusively for leukemia cats, where there is no risk of transmitting the disease to other cats. We were glad to welcome little Winston to our sanctuary. Amazingly, we found a forever home for Winston. Unfortunately there are not many loving homes for leukemia cats, but they always have a safe place at C.A.R.E.. We take many of these sweet babies from many shelters and rescue groups, and we give them the best care possible while they are on this earth or we find them a loving home.
