When I grew up in Europe, it never crossed my mind that I was going to be a rescuer or run an animal Sanctuary. Today I ask myself how I ended up dedicating my adult life to saving dogs and cats from neglect, abuse, abandonment and risk of euthanasia at shelters? It all started when I was stationed in Germany as a military wife and later in Texas when soldiers were reassigned their duties and didn't know what to do with their pets.

After decades of rescue work and thousands of animals saved, I can tell you that being a rescuer and running an animal rescue is not an easy job. The number of animals who are in need of rescue every single day is astonishing. We rescuers understand we cannot save them all at this time, but we can make a big difference for so many. We have shed so many tears and our hearts have been broken so many times at the abuse, neglect, cruelty we have seen and for the ones we cannot save for lack of space or/and financial resources. However, the sun comes up every day with new hope and we are ready to fight the good fight for the innocent creatures who cannot speak for themselves.

A rescuer's day - taking dogs and cats to vet appointments, saving animals who were dumped in desert close to our sanctuary, recruiting volunteers, answering phone calls and e-mails from people who want to give up their pet or who have found a lost or stray animal. We also educate the public on responsible pet ownership, hold fundraisers and spend time with the animals in our care.

But nothing is more rewarding than seeing these once broken spirits, flourish, healthy, happy and trusting humans again. When we look in the eyes of our rescued cats and dogs to see love and to know how grateful they are for the kindness and love they are receiving. Another very rewarding part of our job is delivering a dog or cat to its new forever home. There is no greater satisfaction and pure joy than when a cat or dog who has been through so much is adopted and becomes beloved family member.

I truly believe we are all put on this earth for a reason; my reason is to save animals and to try to leave this world a better place that I found it. I hope when I am gone that my legacy will be "she was here and left a safer future for all animals".

Well my dear friends, I can have my heartbroken, many sleepless nights and do the difficult and hard work, but I cannot do it alone. I need your help and generosity to be able to help these poor innocent cats and dogs.
